LOGOS POLICIES

ARRANGEMENT FOR VISITORS

Visitors are welcome and encouraged at LOGOS. After a friend visits three times, the parents will be provided a registration packet and expected to register their child. Please consider the outreach ministry that can happen through this program and thoughtfully encourage your children to invite their friends who do not have a church home. The cost of dinner for non-registered children is \$2.00 per meal. **A friend cannot be transported from school to Logos unless prior notice is given to the church office.**

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation is provided from Centennial, Northridge and the Middle School to the church. Please see the registration enclosed to indicate transportation needed. A transportation list is kept in the CE Office as well as with each elementary school office. If your child is not going to be riding to church for any reason, please notify the church office so that the driver and the school can be notified.

COMPUTER USE

St Paul UCC has three computers in the library for homework assignments. Time allotments for their use will be in effect as needed. Security software has been installed.

CELL PHONES AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

Cell phones and electronic equipment will be turned off and put away. If you need to reach your child during LOGOS, please call the church office.

SAFETY ISSUE

When your child arrives for LOGOS, he or she will not be permitted to leave the building until the conclusion of the program. If your child needs to leave early, we will need a parent's permission.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Scholarships are available to help families with registration costs. Anyone interested in a scholarship may indicate it on the registration form or contact Marilyn Deever, Director of Christian Education, in the church office for further information. Names of all scholarship recipients and donors are kept confidential.

PARENT PARTICIPATION

The teachers and leaders (30+ people) are voluntary. Part time service by a large number of people is essential to keep the many and varied activities going. Even more important, however, is the effect of parents' and other church members' physical presence, visible support, and faith-filled connection with our children and youth.
